You only get one slice.

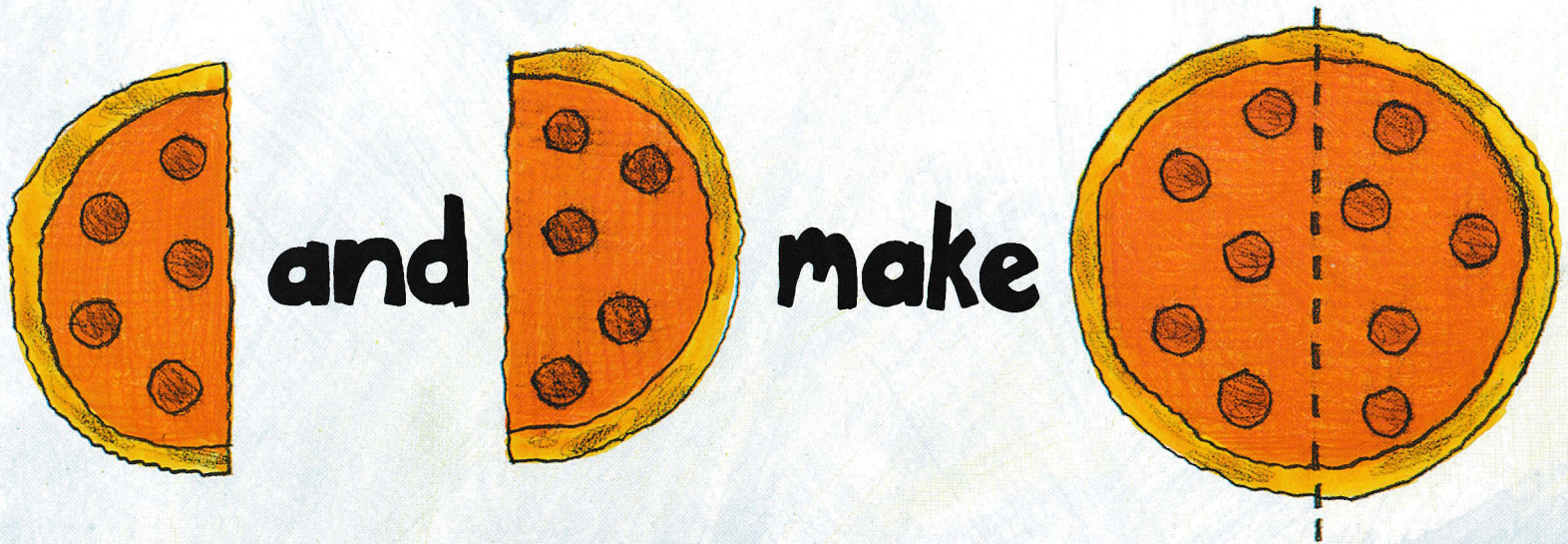


You'd better give me more than that.

$\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ is **1**

$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = \mathbf{1}$
